




Program Updates

Welcome to the first issue of the SRP ENERGY STAR Homes insider! The SRP ENERGY STAR Homes Program team will send out this quarterly newsletter to help keep budders and rates up to date on program changes, requirements and benefits. We know you are busy, so we hope this newsletter will provide quick reminders on often and/or deadlines that may be coming your way.

When SRP's new fiscal year stated on May 1, 2021, we announced two changes that will go into effect on Nov 1, 2021. First, all homes must have 50%. LED lighting and this must be demonstrated in your submittal to SRP. Please check with your rater to make sure this has been updated on your submittals to first checked. Second, all homes must have bEHERO'S YRA credited appliances if straighted by the bullotic including the dishreather, refrigeratio, clothes washer and dyer. Any home southflash without there two updates with not be accepted after Col. 31, 2021.

The programs fiscal year is from May 1, 2021, through April 30, 2022. Builders earn performance incentives by improving energy efficiency on each home at \$1.40 per May Incentives are determined by the home to tatel estimated annual MNP average as compared to a code-built flower. The builder's raters shall determine the Why assings using Ebchrope software SP8 PM largy incentives for eighler homes on a first-come, first-served basis until all incentive flurding has been depleted for the fiscal year. Currently, the SPR ENERGY STAR Homes Program has 68% of the rebate funding available.

Builders may earn an additional incentive of \$300 per home for Electric Vehicle-Ready homes.
